

Summary Report of Occurrences Reviewed From September 1 – 8, 2006

Summary: 20 occurrences at 12 sites reviewed during this period.

Significant Occurrences (1)

Near Misses – 1 occurrence at 1 site

- ***RL – Plutonium Finishing Plant (Significance Category 2).*** On September 5, 2006, an employee working on the grating level of a tank bumped a free-hanging abandoned conduit support with the top of a ladder, causing it to fall into the pit below. The support rod landed on the pit floor approximately five feet from workers performing work in the pit.
