On September 13, the control room at the Bryan Mound Strategic Petroleum Reserve site was notified that an Ashton contract employee had been injured on a riding lawn tractor. An ambulance was requested at Cavern 005. The site Emergency Response Team responded and began performing CPR. The injured employee was transported to Brazosport Memorial Hospital. Accident scene was taped off and an investigation is ongoing. The exact cause of the fatality has not been determined at this time.
