## Facsimile Transmission Service

#### I PURPOSE

This Instruction:

- A Sets forth procedures for using the Federal Telecommunications System (FTS) to transmit data by facsimile terminal equipment, and
- B Prescribes how to obtain approvals for the installation of facsimile transmission equipment in offices of the Agricultural Marketing Service (AMS), Federal Grain Inspection Service (FGIS), and Office of Transportation (OT).

### II AVAILABILITY OF SERVICE

- A Facsimile transmission service is currently available through machines operated by the General Services Administration (GSA) and by AMS and FGIS between the locations serviced directly by the FTS voice network (see Exhibit A, attached, for GSA locations).
- B \*-The FTS voice network is available under controlled conditions for agency facsimile transmissions. No off-net originating service is available. Off-net terminating service is available only by special arrangements with GSA.-\*

### III APPROVALS REQUIRED

- A <u>GSA-Operated Machines</u>. Agency approval is not required for AMS, FGIS, or OT offices to use GSA-operated machines. GSA will bill offices for transmissions (see Section IV B, below).
- B \*-Agency-Operated Machines. Offices wishing to arrange for the installation of facsimile equipment shall take the following actions:

  - h If equipment is to be leased or purchased.-\*
  - i If a facsimile transmission machine is located within the same building, the reason why it will not satisfy requirements.
  - j Type of information to be transmitted, and reason facsimile transmission required.
- \* \*-2 AMS and OT offices shall forward the justification
  \* memorandum containing the information cited above to the Division or
  \* Agency Administrative Officer for submission to the Communications
  \* Section, Communications and Operations Branch, Administrative Services
  \* (AS) Division.

- b Regional Administrative Officers and FGIS Washington headquarters offices shall send requests to the Administrative Staff, FGIS, for submission to the Communications Section, Communications and Operations Branch, AS Division.

Agency, or Regional Administrative Officer, whichever is applicable, and a copy to the Communications and Operations Branch, AS Division, to be received by no later than the fifth day of the following quarter.

b Each Administrative Officer shall prepare a Form GSA-2830, Individual Terminal Report of FTS Intercity Data Transmission, to report the number of calls and minutes used for each terminal location. Show on the report the street address, room number, city, State, and ZIP code, for each terminal. For information purposes, also list all terminals used between 7:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., Monday through Friday (except holidays), and those used any time on weekends or holidays. Submit the report no later than 30 days after the end of the quarter to:

- 3 <u>Billings</u>. When quarterly bills for agency-operated machines are received from GSA, the Administrative Officer shall:
  - a Administratively approve the bill for payment, by signing and entering title.
  - b Prepare and code Form AMS-542, Accounting Authorization and Classification (Apron), to cover the bill.
  - c Forward the original Form AMS-542, with the bill, to the Fiscal Operations and Systems Branch, Financial Management (FM) Division, for payment.
  - B GSA-Operated Facsimile Machines.
- 1 Service. GSA provides facsimile services for transmitting documents such as letters, contracts, charts, photographs, drawings, and validating signatures. Any size copy up to 8 1/2 x 11 inches can be transmitted. Larger copies may be handled by special arrangement. All offices are authorized to use GSA services where available. A listing of GSA Facsimile Service Locations is shown in Exhibit A, attached.

- 2 <u>Billings</u>. GSA will send monthly bills directly to the Administrative Officer for the total number of pages sent over GSA-operated machines, based on current rates. The Administrative Officer shall:
  - a Administratively approve the bill for payment, by signing and entering title.
  - b Prepare and code Form AMS-542 to cover the bill.
  - c Forward the original Form AMS-542, with the bill, to the Fiscal Operations and Systems Branch, FM Division, for payment.
