**Provider Name:** WISP Guam, Inc.

**Summary:** We are a new company on Guam, our majority shareholders are women and are of minority descent, and we began our services in February of 2008. We provide an alternative solution to data transport locally via wireless bridges and access points to commercial customers; and we can provide infrastructure to any location covered under this grant at a fraction of the cost of fiber with the same reliability. WISP Guam, Inc. is opposed to the IT&E's BTOP, Round 2 Application as:

1. we are also proposing services for a school on Guam (i.e., George Washington High School, temporary location);
2. we are currently responding to a tender for the linking of several local medical clinics with the Guam Memorial Hospital Telemedicine system;
