Subj: NAVY MEDICINE POLICY-EXCEPTION TO POLICY GUIDANCE FOR THE INTEGRATED DISABILITY EVALUATION SYSTEM (IDES)

- 1. Per references (a) and (b) effective immediately doctoral level clinical psychologists are authorized to sign Medical Evaluation Boards (MEB) that contain a psychological health diagnosis. Any MEB listing a psychological health diagnosis must contain a thorough psychological health evaluation and include the signature of a minimum of one privileged psychiatrist or doctoral level clinical psychologist. The existing requirement restricting MEB membership to psychiatrists (vice doctoral level psychologists) for MEBs containing at least one psychological health diagnosis is waived.
