### DOE Trans EX Requirements

- DOE M 460.2-1 Office of Transportation Safeguards must conduct exercises regularly, along with annual in-service tests for DOE response elements
- DOE O 460.2A Evaluate transportation and packaging operations at each facility every 3 years
  - SRS auditors check for conduct of transportation exercise or evaluation of actual response





### **TEPP Model**

- TEPP exercise model is based on both DOE and DHS standards/guidance
  - Some elements are from 151.1C orders and guides
  - Communities are required to evaluate drills using DHS evaluation criteria





### DHS Exercise Guidance

- ▶ TEPP expressed concerns in Aug. '05 regarding DHS guides :
  - Model did not mention narrative, timeline, MSEL, messages, or supporting data
  - Safety, schedules, lists of participants, and logistics were discussed redundantly
  - Exercise criteria were included, but were not user friendly
- ▶ DHS added Volume V to its guidance, and revised Volumes I-IV in Feb. '07
  - Evaluation criteria easier to use





### TEPP Exercise Objectives

- ▶ TEPP combines best of both DOE and DHS guidance
  - Objective 1: Initial Notifications
  - Objective 2: Direction and Control
  - ▶ Objective 3: Incident Assessment
  - Objective 4: Resource Management
  - Objective 5: Communications
  - Objective 6: Facilities, Equipment,& Displays



### TEPP Exercise Objectives

- ▶ Objective 7: Public Alert/Notifications
- Objective 8: Emergency Information/Media
- Objective 9: Protective Actions
- Objective 10: Response Personnel Safety
- Objective 11: Traffic & Access Control





### TEPP Exercise Objectives

- Objective 12: Registration, Screening & Decontamination of the Public
- Objective 13: Congregate Care
- Objective 14: Emergency Medical Services
- Objective 15: Containment and Cleanup
- Objective 16: Documentation/Investigation





# Standardizing Evaluation

- Recommendations
  - Incorporate standard objectives, criteria and LOIs in Exercise Builder for evaluation of transportation exercises at DOE sites
  - Consider standard objectives for <u>all</u> exercises
    - Objectives should be based on requirements
    - ▶ DHS criteria should be considered
    - ▶ DHS (including FEMA) and DOE should cooperate to improve standards and guidance for exercise conduct/evaluation
    - Criteria and LOIs may vary between sites
