




THEN - The Old West

 - The Media will tell us the "truth".






NOW - Modern Times

Reaching Out

- Fact: Pantex is prepared for credible events.
 - Emergency personnel respond.
 - Categorize/classify the event.
 - Notify off-site agencies, warn the public.
 - Work to resolve the event.
 - Keep the public informed through the media:
 - Periodic press conferences.
 - One-on-one contacts.
 - Phone contacts.

It's All About Working Together

- Partnering with Off-Site Agencies:
 - Participate in Agreement-In-Principle (AIP).
 - Participate in Local Emergency Planning Committees (LEPC).
 - Develop joint response capabilities (mutual aid agreements, etc.).
 - Participate in/conduct drills and exercises:
 - Assist with planning.
 - Provide controllers/evaluators.
 - Use site-specific scenarios.
