The EPI Subcommittee met on Tuesday, January 22, 2013, via conference call.

2012–2013 Objectives Status Update

The EMI SIG EPI Subcommittee identified objectives for the 2012–2013 planning period per a survey conducted after the 2012 Annual Meeting. The following are objectives for the 2012-2013 planning period:

- 1. Develop a list of social media resources needed to sustain alternate JIC operations for a sustained event.
 - Status: **Complete**. A social media resources survey was distributed to the EPI Subcommittee via the listserv in December 2012. Survey results were used to create a social media resources wiki on the EPI Subcommittee SharePoint. Subcommittee members are encouraged to add to this wiki and use as a resource.
- 2. Develop a resource list of media monitoring tools that may be used by DOE/NNSA sites.



- Status: **Complete.** A social media monitoring survey was distributed to the EPI Subcommittee via the listserv in December 2012. Survey results were used to create a social media resources wiki on the EPI Subcommittee SharePoint. Subcommittee members are encouraged to add to this wiki and use as a resource.
- 3. Partner with other EMI SIG working groups/subcommittees (COOPWG, TECHWG, Exercise and Drill Subcommittee, etc.) via conference call or webinar during the annual planning period to discuss lessons learned, common issues and share ideas.

Status: Continuous objective, though the objective was met during the October 2012 EPI Subcommittee Live Meeting webinar. There are continued information sharing opportunities with the EPI Subcommittee and other EMI SIG groups at the 2013 EMI SIG Annual Meeting.
