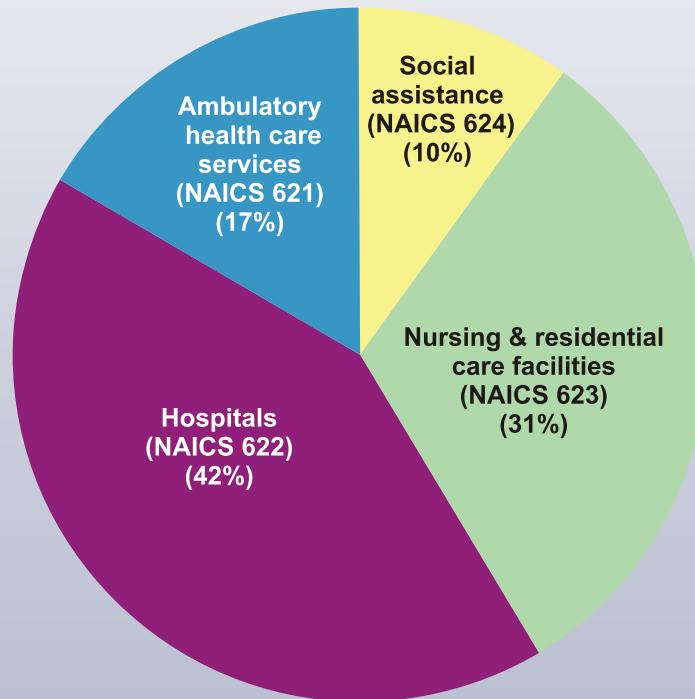
The health care and social assistance industry accounted for nearly 95 percent of injuries and illnesses within the education and health services major industry sector in 2005.

Hospitals alone accounted for more than 40 percent of all reported cases in health care and social assistance in 2005, reporting more cases (281,500) than any other industry.

Nursing and residential care facilities and ambulatory health care services reported 209,100 and 110,600 cases, respectively.
