Conference Overview

Vehicle Entry to Fort Leavenworth. Attendees who are traveling for this event and desire to conduct business at Ft. Leavenworth driving a rental vehicle should enter through the main gate on Grant Avenue. The far right lane is reserved for vehicle inspections – you need NOT enter through that lane. You may proceed through any open regular entry lane on the left and present your current CAC card (military, civilian, or contractor) or active duty military ID card along with the vehicle rental agreement (see diagram below). If the driver's name is on the rental agreement, you can enter post in this manner for the duration of the event. However, if there will be more than one driver for the rental vehicle, the person on the rental agreement must go to Vehicle Registration on post (see Google Map) and request a pass for each of the other drivers of that vehicle.

If you do not possess a CAC or military ID card then you will need prior approval from the Provost Marshall Office (PMO) in order to get passes for the post. You will need to contact Mr. Cashin at (913) 684-3536. Please let him know the reason for the visit and what length of time you will need the pass. He will then notify the vehicle registration office of your name if approved to receive a pass.
