Item 1: Enter the newborn's full name (Last, First, Middle). If no middle name, leave blank.

Item 2: Check the appropriate gender box.

Item 3: Enter the newborn's date of birth in the mm-dd-yyyy format.

Item 4: Strike out either A.M. or P.M. (whichever is inapplicable) and enter the conventional local time as shown on the birth certificate. (Example: 3:00 p.m.)

Item 5: Enter the newborn's city and country of birth. Do not enter military installation.

Item 6: Enter the full name of biological Parent A (father). Enter the biological Parent B (mother's) married name followed by maiden name in parenthesis as shown above.

Item 7: Enter the biological parent's dates of birth in the mm-dd-yyyy format.

Item 8: Enter the biological parent's places of birth. If born in the US, enter city, State, and USA. If born in a foreign country, enter the city and country.

Item 9: Enter the biological parent's current address. You may enter the sponsor's unit address or local residence address for both entries.

Item 10: Enter the biological parent's permanent resident address in the US. You cannot enter

a foreign address in this section.

Item 11: Enter the biological parent's proof of U.S. citizenship. You may use a birth certificate, report of birth abroad, naturalization certificate, or passport. If one spouse is a foreign national, enter his/her nationality only.

Item 12: Enter the biological parent's periods of physical residence in the U.S in the mm-dd-yyyy format. Use a continuation sheet if necessary to list additional periods.

Item 13: Enter the biological parent's periods of physical residence abroad in the mm-dd-yyyy format, as well as the branch of service. The "To" date on the current physical presence date should be "Present" (needs to be handwritten). Use a continuation sheet if necessary to list additional periods.

Item 14: Enter the biological parent's previous marriage information in the mm-dd-yyyy format. Use a continuation sheet if necessary to list additional marriages. If not previously married, enter "None".

Item 15: Enter the biological parent's date of present marriage in the mm-dd-yyyy format, and place of present marriage. If married in the US, enter city, State, and USA. If married in a foreign country, enter the city and country.

DOCUMENTATION SUBMITTED WITH DS-2029

When you appear in front of a notar public to sign this form you must provide the following additional documentation:

1. The newborn's birth certificate (presealed in an envelope by the hospital where the newborn was delivered).
2. Original evidence of biological parent's U.S. citizenship (birth certificate, report of birth abroad, naturalization certificate, passport).
3. Original marriage certificate for the biological parents.
4. Original documents showing the termination of all marriage for both biological parents (divorce decree, annulment decree, death certificate).
5. Certified copy of additional picture ID for biological parents (military ID, drivers license, etc.).
