## 3. Objective/Purpose: Informational

Purpose of this presentation is to provide MAFAC with an overview of the Healthy Oceans Goal which is largely the NOAA Fisheries portfolio.

**4. Background/Synopsis**: At an earlier MAFAC meeting an overview of the **NOAA Next Generation Strategic Plan (NGSP)**, adopted in late fall 2010, was provided. As a result of the NGSP a new planning structure was developed which organizes NOAA capabilities by strategic goals and enterprises. **Healthy Oceans** is one of four strategic goals, which represent NOAA's long-term core mission functions. NOAA's strategy would be incomplete without detailing the enterprise-wide capabilities required to achieve the environmental, social, and economic outcomes targeted by the strategic goals. NOAA's enterprises comprise three groups: foundational science and technology functions that generate research and development, models, and environmental observations; distinct functions for engaging partners and customers; and underlying administration and management functions that support all NOAA work.

Specifically the **Healthy Oceans long term goal is**: Marine fisheries, habitats, and biodiversity sustained within healthy and productive ecosystems. Within the **Healthy Oceans Goal**, NOAA is pursuing four objectives within the next five years:

- Objective: Improved understanding of ecosystems to inform resource management decisions
- Objective: Recovered and healthy marine and coastal species.
- Objective: Healthy habitats that sustain resilient and thriving marine resources and communities.
- Objective: Sustainable fisheries and safe seafood for healthy populations and vibrant communities.
