The purpose is to educate MAFAC on the challenges being faced in 2012. By challenges we include internal and external drivers of the regulatory and science agenda and what our strategy(ies) will be to resolve the challenge. For example, demand for more (regulatory/policy/data/assessment) services is a driver; what and where specifically are they expected to be coming from in 2012 (e.g., Hill, White House, Councils, ENGOs, NOAA Leadership, fishing communities, consumers, etc)? How do we prioritize them? Budget is an obvious driver; how do we plan to conduct business with a flat or reduced budget?
