Total Expenditure: \$30,617,632

Infrastructure: Repair of the Tarnak Bridge, a 280 meter bridge that crosses the Tarnak River. *Rule of Law and Governance:* Construction of the Farah Court of Appeals.

Healthcare: Strong Food Program, this program provided over 400 infants nourishing formula, and 40 Village medical out-reach projects provided care for over 16,000 Afghans.

Education: Bibi Kali Girl's School - renovation of an all-girls' school for 1500 students in Zabul. **Electricity:** "District 1" Electrification provided electricity to Farah including the hospital and over 3,000 homes; in Herat City a million dollar electrical grid was established.

Water and Sanitation: 201 wells dug.

Agriculture: Spring Wheat Seed distributed 170 metric tons of wheat seed across Zabul province; TF FURY provided equipment to the Ministry of Rural Reconstruction.

Civic Clean-up: Refuse pick-up throughout Qalat City and management of the landfill site. Micro Grants: Community micro grants to Afghan citizens to buy \$5K of equipment for contracting or construction businesses.

ANSF Infrastructure: Constructed the Zabul Police HQ and a new Police Training Center.
