

## NXS School Group Presentations

Friday, 12:45 p.m., 25 June 2010

Each of the 12 groups of participants in the NXS School will make a presentation about one experiment (either Neutron or X-ray) in which they participated during the School.

- Each group will prepare a single presentation and select a member of their group to present it on their behalf. The other members of the group will participate as panel members during the talk.
- Each talk is limited to 10 minutes (with 5 minutes for Q&A at the end).
- The audience will be your fellow NXS School students and several instrument scientists.

The Neutron School Science Directors, John Budai and Bryan Chakoumakos, will evaluate and rank each presentation on its merits, and a *special prize* will be awarded to the members of the group with the best presentation.

“Advice from the Judges”:

- Start early to identify a member of your group who will make the presentation on behalf of the group.
- Work on the presentation together during the week. Don't wait until the last minute!
