LTG Odom leaves a legacy to this Agency, the Intelligence Community and this country that reflects the ultimate in dedication, commitment and excellence.

As he pins the medal on LTG Odom's chest, the President congratulates LTG Odom and says he is very pleased and proud to be doing so. LTG Odom thanks the President. Applause is heard as Mrs. Odom joins them. The President repeats how pleased and honored he is. Mrs. Odom comments to the President that the ranch must be looking better and better every day and the President agrees heartily. Secretary of Defense Carlucci jokes about how much better LTG Odom looks now that he has retired. LTG Odom thanks the President again for taking the time.
