## Delalio School Counseling Services

DeLalio School Counseling Services adheres to the DoDEA comprehensive K-12 Competency-Based Counseling Program (CBCP) as per the American

School Counseling Association (ASCA) National Standards for School Counseling Programs.

The goal of the CBCP at DeLalio Elementary School is to promote learning by assisting students in mastering skills and developing attitudes necessary to be successful students. A needs assessment is conducted in the spring to determine what DoDEA Student Competencies as well as areas of concerns and needs, to be addressed the following school year..

The mission of DeLalio Counseling Services is to ensure that the DeLalio community prepares students for academic, social, and personal success. The comprehensive counseling program is an integral part of the school's total program and committed to serving our military families.

DeLalio Elementary School's counselor provides counseling services to our students. Incoming student records are reviewed by the counselor and information is shared with teachers, specialists, and administration. Classroom counseling lessons are presented to all K-5 students within the classroom environment. Individual and group counseling services are available to the entire student body as well. Children may see the counselors on a walk-in basis (with permission from their teacher) or may be referred by a parent, teacher or administrator. The counselor interprets standardized testing results for teachers and parents and also serves as liaison with many community resources. The counselor is also a member of the Student Support Team (SST), Student Placement Committee, and Gifted Resource Committee and coordinates TerraNova test administration.



### Success for all Students! Classroom Counseling Services:

All K-5 students receive school counseling services lessons, at least once a month, based on the school counseling needs assessment. These lessons last about 40 minutes in each classroom. They may consist of stories, discussion, video, and/or hands-on activities. Classroom counseling services topics are:

Personal / Social Skills, Character, Study Skills, Anti-Bullying and Conflict Resolution, and Career Exploration.



### Small Group

#### Counseling Services:

Teachers, parents, or students may refer students for small group counseling. The group or topic of focus is based on the needs of the individuals who have been referred. The format for groups is as follows:

- \*4-6 Students in each group
- \*Meet once a week for 6-8 weeks
- \*Parent permission required

Confidentiality is maintained and the counselor facilitates each of the groups. Small Group and Individual Counseling Services currently are:

**Club USA** – for children who have a deployed parent, for the duration of the deployment

### Individual Counseling Services:

A student may be referred for individual counseling in one of the following ways:

- \*Self-referral
- \*Staff/Faculty Referral
- \*Parent Referral

Although the counselor may provide immediate service to an individual student, she would seek parent permission when offering ongoing individual counseling services.
