This CHCO Academy session is designed to provide project management training for strategically-ranked professionals (GS12-14) within the CHCO office. The course will outline a new perspective for developing strategy to more effectively implement human capital initiatives on both the macro and micro levels. It will present an overview of project management concepts and techniques that when institutionalized, will promote an environment of growth for organizational programs and projects.

Some examples of work that might benefit from the use of project management principles include: Workforce Development; Agency Restructuring and Reduction in Force initiatives; and implementation of Performance Improvement Strategy. The human capital management framework is developed to guide our organizations in establishing, documenting and maintaining effective and economically prudent processes and programs supportive of a workforce dedicated to advancing an organizational mission. Project management principles are an effective set of managerial tools that when applied to the human capital development strategy can help cultivate the growth of valuable initiatives and establish processes driven by results.
