10 “CB” Concepts

1. Develop a warm and loving relationship with each child and their family.
2. The child’s needs are #1 so focus on the child’s positive behaviors.
3. Always remain calm. Practice the “15 second rule”. Give the child space.
4. Have quick reaction times. Intervene before there is a problem.
5. Figure out the purpose of the child’s behavior.
6. Anticipate and act in order to decrease, minimize, or prevent a child’s “CB”.
7. Follow through be consistent. “Guide” child into doing “right thing” and it will be their idea.
8. Have a cue between teachers that means “HELP”.
9. It may be necessary to leave your “home ways” at home.
10. Practice positive problem-solving.
