Performance Coal Company, Upper Big Branch Mine-South (ID 46-08436), is submitting the Panel 20 pullout ventilation plan, Panel 11A set-up ventilation plan and proposed ventilation for Panel 11A during mining. The proposed ventilation schemes for the above are shown on the three attached drawings.

When equipment is removed from Panel 20 longwall, all equipment will be recovered from the headgate side.

Upon start up of the longwall in Panel 11A, a recvaluation of the entire longwall bleeder system will be made. This will include quantity, quality and direction of all air entering the bleeder system including all EP's at or near the mouths of all longwall headgates and any other air entering the bleeder from returns from continuous miner sections. A sketch showing all EP's and all other areas where air enters the longwall bleeder system will be submitted to MSHA. This sketch will show quantity and air direction at all these locations.
