

# PROJECT EVALUATION CRITERIA

The Trustee Council will consider the extent to which projects:

- Provide benefits with a close relationship to the impacted natural resources and services, and to the spill location
- Have a very high likelihood of success
- Avoid additional impacts to natural resources
- Comply with relevant and applicable laws

# PROJECT EVALUATION CRITERIA

(cont.)

The Trustee Council will consider the extent to which projects:

- Provide the appropriate type and quality benefits
- Provide long lasting benefits and a way to protect those benefits
- Provide benefits to multiple types of impacted resources and services
- Have a potential for collaborative funding or implementation from other sources

## Wetlands / Mudflats Habitat Category \*

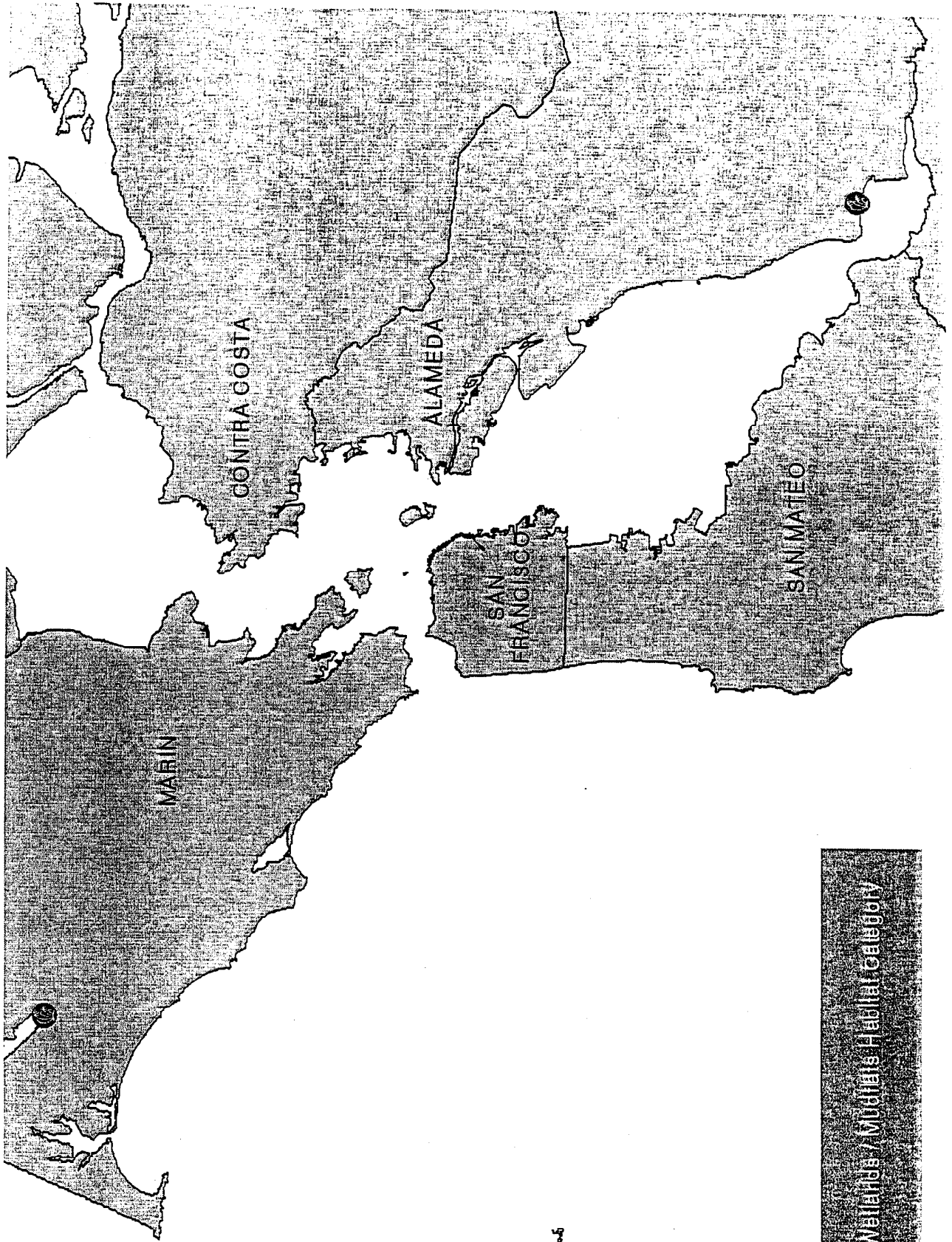
- Giacomini Wetland Restoration: \$300,000
- Entry-Triangle Marsh Restoration: \$50,000

- Beach and Dune Enhancements: \$250,400
- Reef Restoration and Visitor Uses: \$360,000

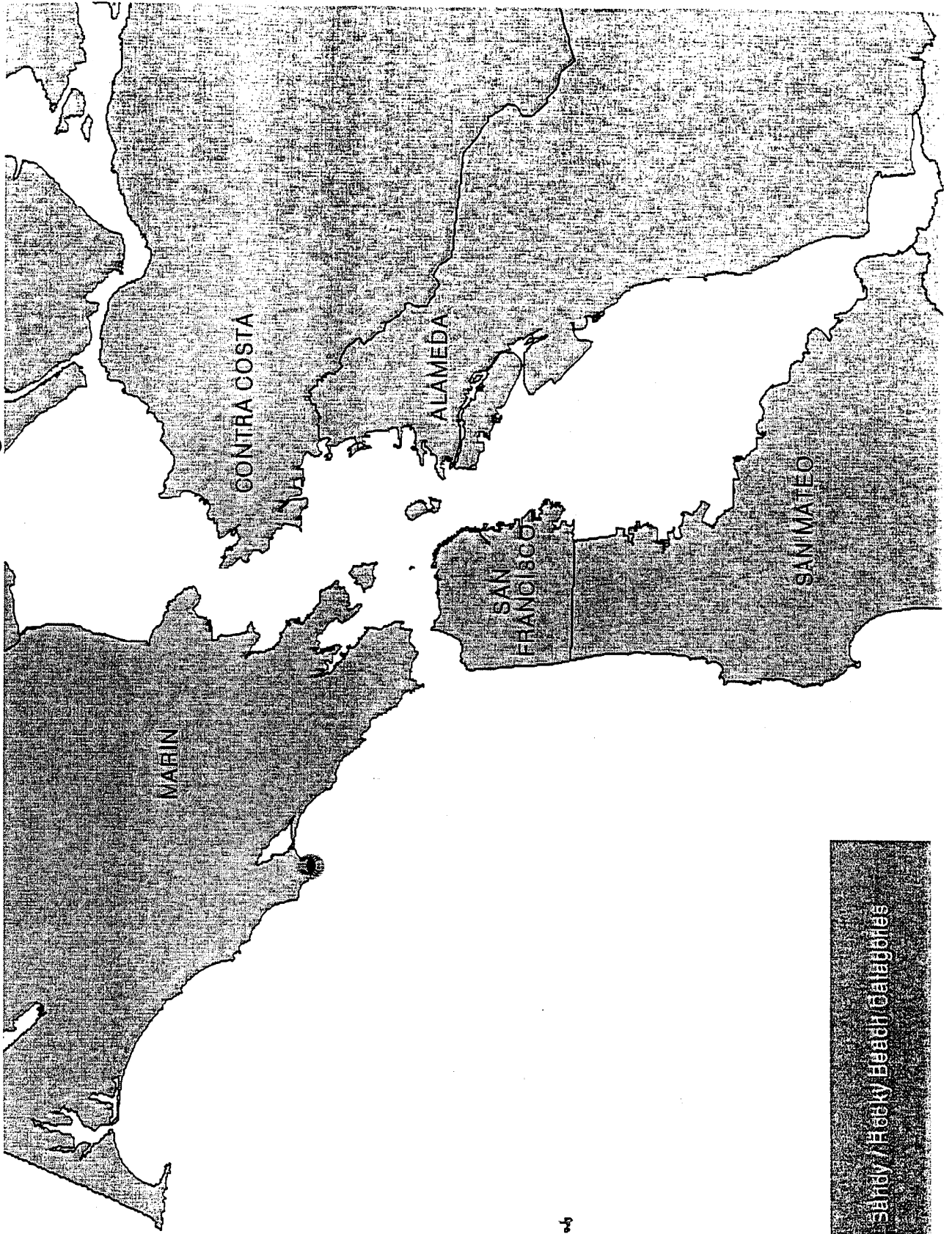

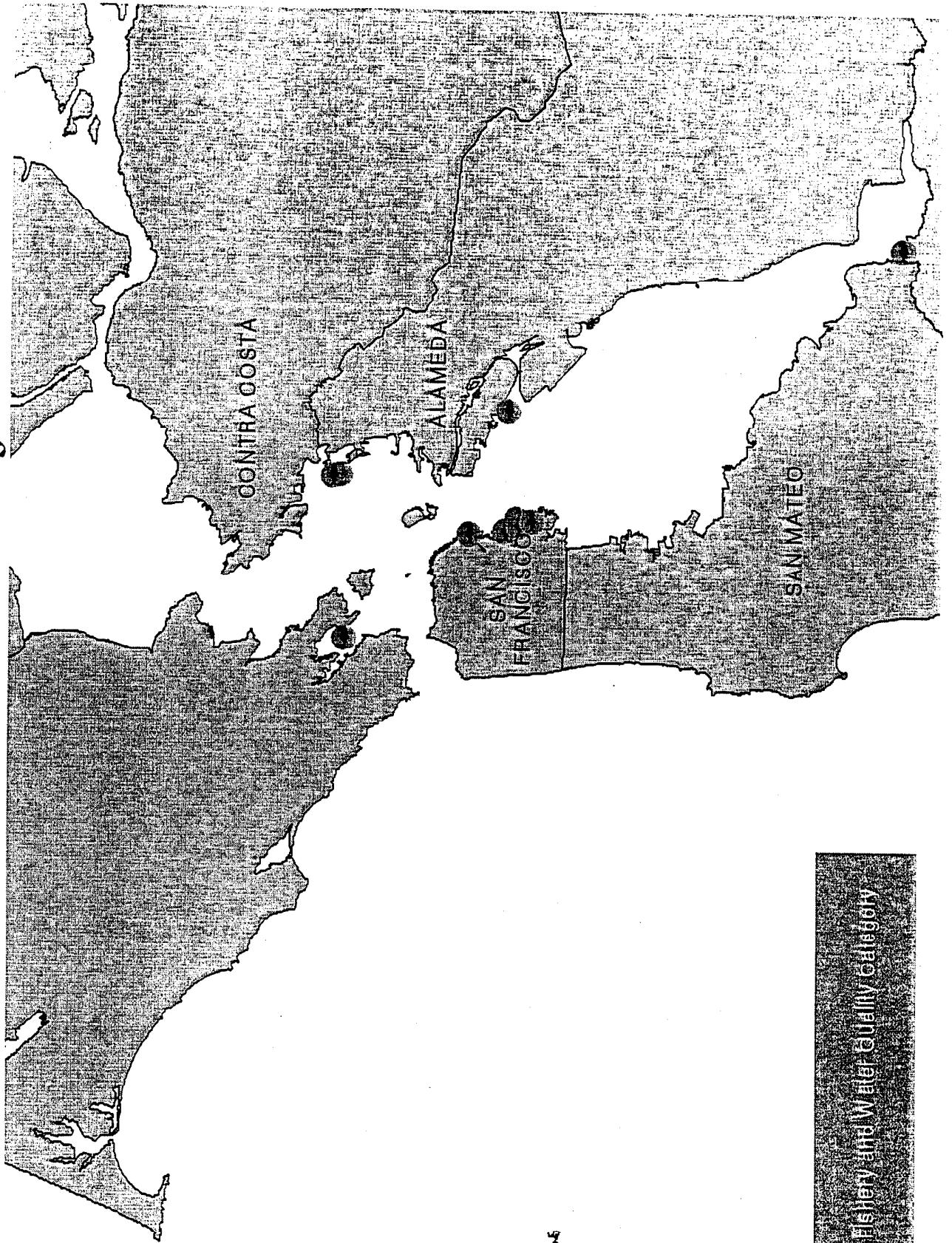
# Potential Restoration Projects

## Fisheries and Water Quality Category \*

- Herring Spawning Habitat: \$148,500
- Eelgrass Restoration: \$392,700
- Wrap Creosote Piling: \$120,000 - \$425,000
- Habitat Restoration at Pier 94: \$307,000
- Habitat Restoration at Pier 98: \$254,300
- Stream Habitat Enhancement: \$ 20,000

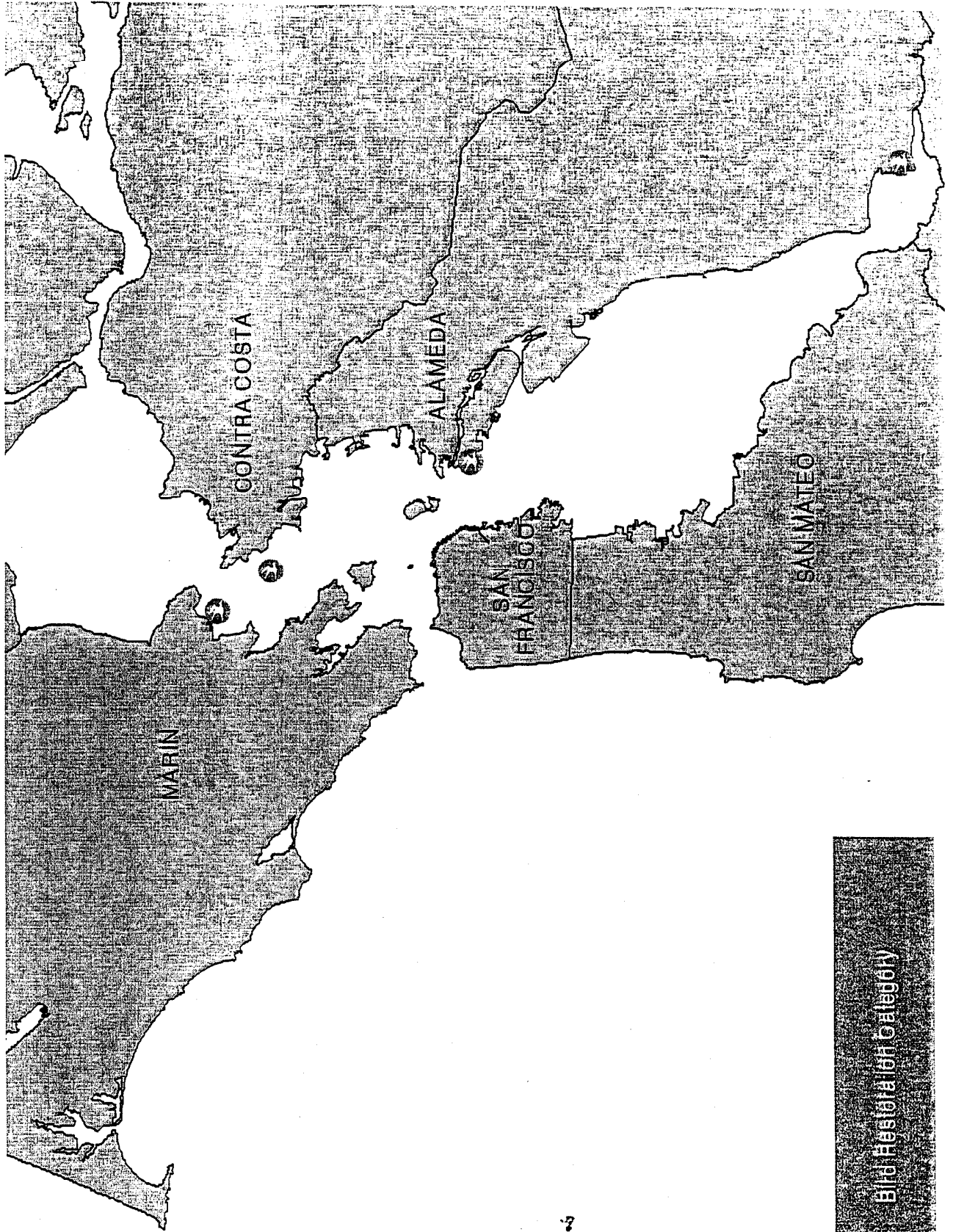
# Potential Restoration Projects

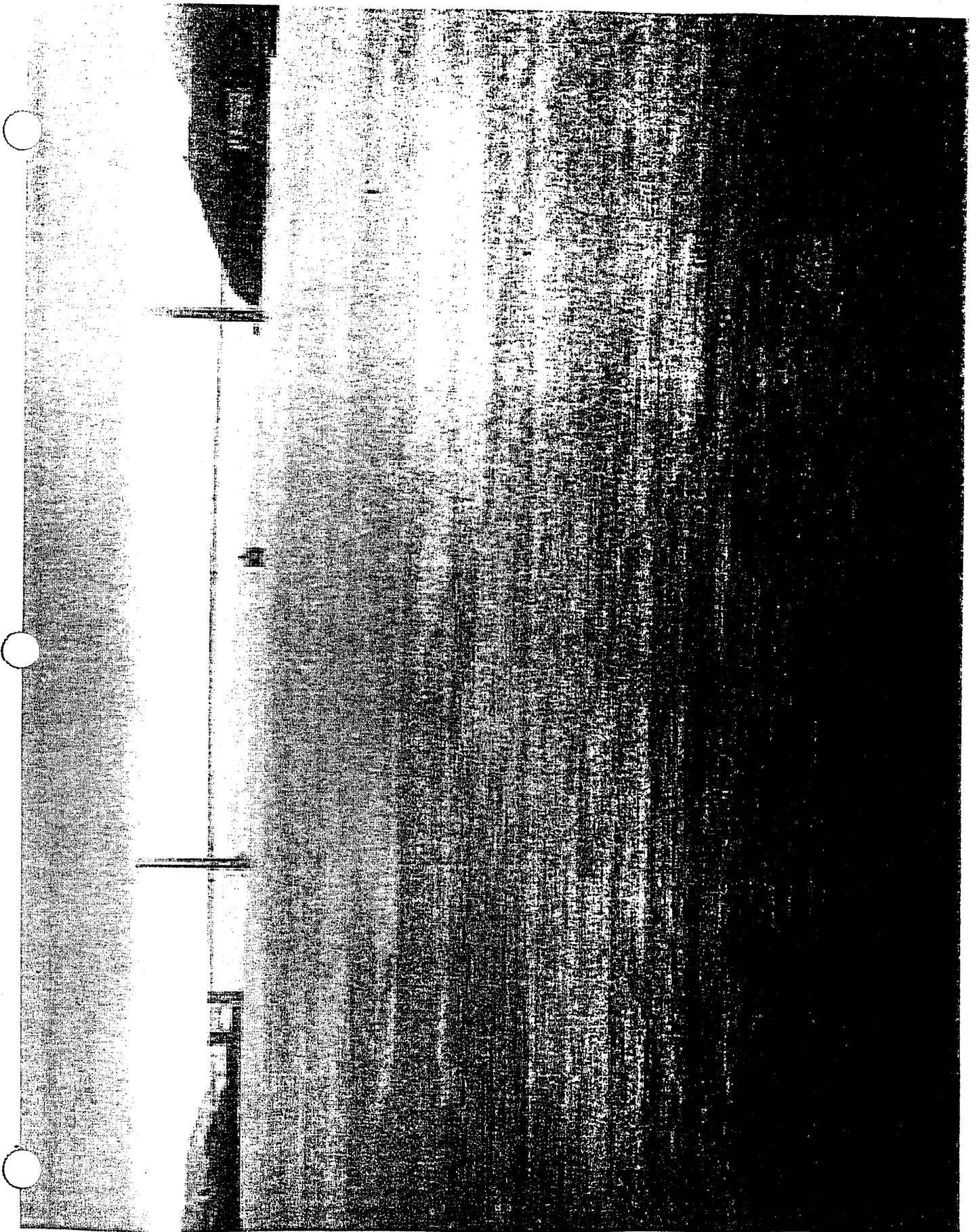

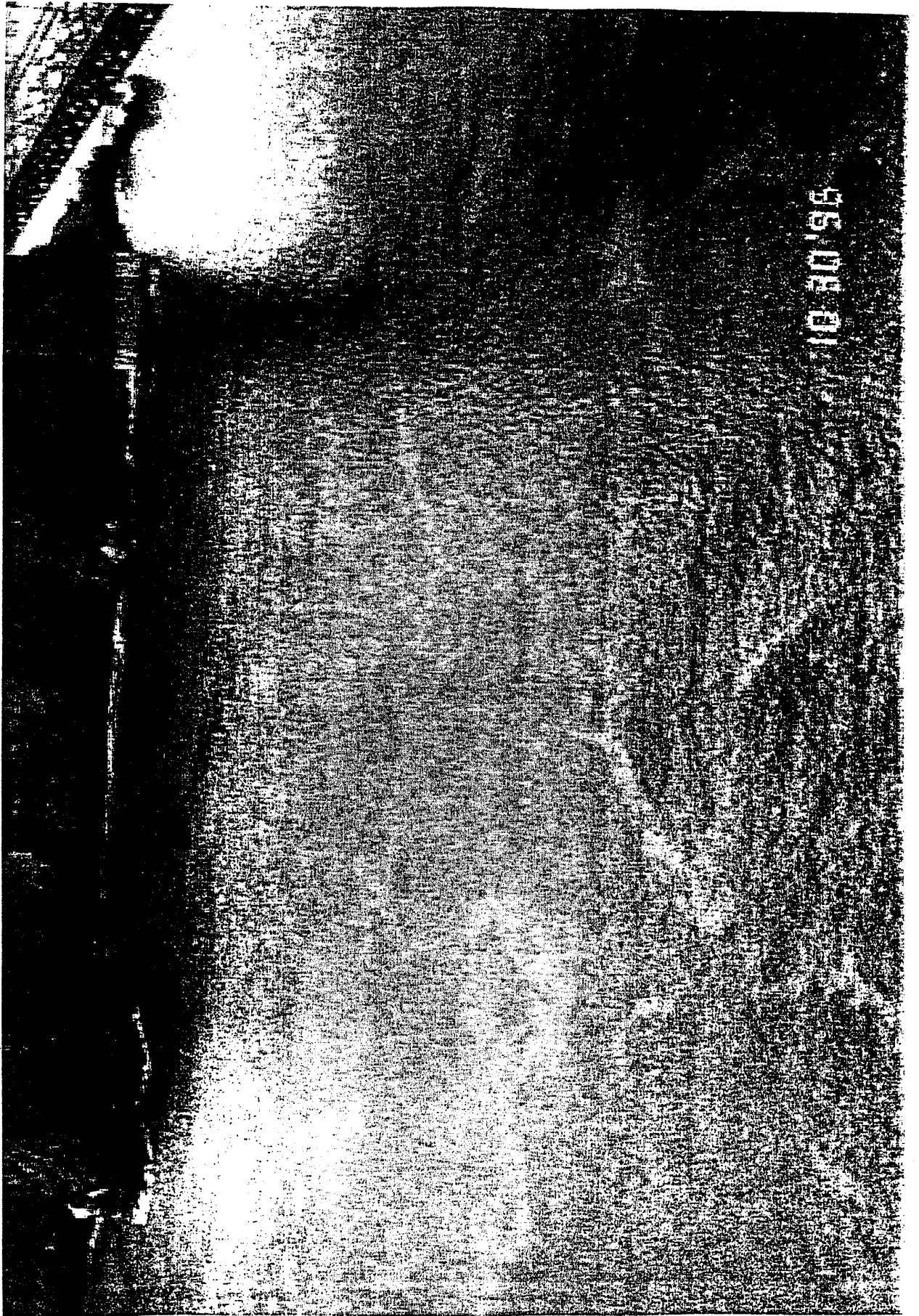
