## **REQUIRED SUBMITTAL FOR A REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF AIRPORT PROPERTY**

FAA requires the following:

- Letter to FAA addressing the following:
  - 1) List all obligating agreements with the United States
  - 2) Type of release or modification requested
  - 3) Reasons for requesting the release
  - 4) The facts and circumstances that justify the request
  - 5) The requirements of state or local law, which must be included in any approval document
  - 6) A description of the property
  - 7) A description of how the sponsor acquired the property
  - 8) The present condition and use of the property
  - 9) The expected use of disposition of the property
  - 10) The fair market value of the property
  - 11) Discussion of lease vs. sale of the property
  - 12) Proceeds expected as a result of the release and the expected use of revenues derived
  - 13) Describe any intangible benefits and the merits of the application as an offset against the fair market value of the property. Any non-aviation interest of the sponsor of the surrounding community does not constitute a benefit resulting from a release.
  - 14) The airport's source and application of funds for the preceding 3 years
  - 15) Future sources and application of funds needed for continued operation and maintenance of the airport
  - 16) The financial capability and intent to accomplish airport included in the current ALP
  - 17) An environmental review of the anticipated development on the property to be released.
  - 18) FAA Form 7460-1
- Exhibits to accompany the request:
  - 1) A scaled drawing showing all airport property and facilities obligated for airport purposes
  - 2) Appraisal report
  - 3) Revised ALP and Exhibit "A" Property Map
  - 4) Height data computations
  - 5) A Deed of Release, if applicable
  - 6) Copy of proposed conveyance instrument (lease or deed)
- Expected timeline (cumulative):

FAA review (Compliance Specialist, Airport Planner & Environmental Specialist) – 30 days

FAA Publication in Federal Register – 90 days FAA approval – 120 days
