SUBJECT: Meeting with American Bankers Association

On February 16, 2011, Chairperson Bair and FDIC staff met with representatives of the American Bankers Association to discuss regulatory burden issues. Among other things, the topics for discussion included the following matters arising out of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act: brokered and core deposit issues, which is the subject of an FDIC study under section 1506 of the Act due later this year; and the new risk retention requirement which is subject to joint rulemaking under section 941 of that Act. Of particular concern to the ABA were the standards for "qualifying residential mortgages" and their potential impact on mid-sized and smaller banks.
