Subject: Meeting with Merchants Payment Coalition

On March 14, 2011, FDIC Deputy Director of Policy and Research, Division of Depositor & Consumer Protection and other FDIC staff met with representatives of the Merchants Payment Coalition (MPC) at the request of the MPC to discuss the MPC's views on debit card interchange fees and routing, as addressed in section 1075 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act and the Federal Reserve Board's proposed rule implementing Section 1075. Topics discussed included debit card interchange fees and the potential impact of the debit card interchange provision on community banks.
