Yesterday and today, Thomas J. Tauke, Executive Vice President Public Affairs, Policy and Communications, Verizon; James W. Cicconi, Senior Executive Vice President External & Legislative Affairs, AT&T Inc.; Kyle E. McSlarrow, President & CEO, National Cable & Telecommunications Association; Richard Whitt, Senior Telecommunications and New Media Counsel, Google; Christopher Libertelli, Senior Director of Government and Regulatory Affairs, Skype; and the undersigned met with Edward Lazarus, Chief of Staff, Federal Communications Commission; Paul de Sa, Chief, Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis, Federal Communications Commission; and Zachary Katz, Deputy Chief, Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis, Federal Communications Commission.

We discussed details relating to prospective legislation relating to open Internet principles. Specifically, we discussed –

- Prohibitions on blocking legal content and interfering with attachment of nonharmful devices;
- Possible legislative language for a nondiscrimination principle;
- Treatment of specialized services;
- Transparency of broadband Internet service performance and network management practices;
- An enforcement regime to protect consumers; and
- The applicability of the principles to wireless platforms.
