On July 27, 2010, James W. Cicconi, Senior Executive Vice President External & Legislative Affairs, AT&T Inc., and Kyle E. McSlarrow, President and CEO of the National Cable & Telecommunications Association (participating by telephone), met with Edward P. Lazarus, Chief of Staff to Chairman Genachowski, and Zachary Katz, Deputy Chief, Office of Strategic Planning & Policy Analysis. At the meeting, the participants discussed matters relating to potential legislation concerning a regulatory framework for promoting Internet openness. In particular, the participants discussed prohibitions against blocking lawful Internet content; standards for preventing unreasonable discrimination that materially harms consumers or competition; transparent disclosures of service capabilities and limitations; the treatment of broadband IP-based services other than Internet access service; and methods for addressing complaints related to Internet openness.
