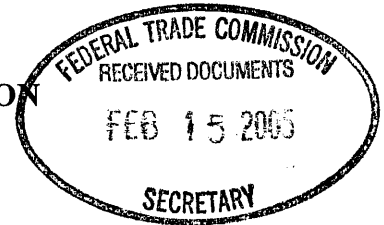



STIPULATION REGARDING ADMISSIBILITY OF
EXHIBITS CX00018, CX00144, CX00405 AND CX01687

At the February 8, 2005 final prehearing conference, Respondent Evanston Northwestern Healthcare Corporation (“ENH”) raised specific objections to the admissibility of Complaint Counsel exhibits CX00018, CX00144, CX00405 and CX01687. Consistent with the Court’s order concerning these specific objections, and pursuant to the Joint Stipulations Regarding Admissibility Of Trial Exhibits dated February 10, 2005, the parties further stipulate that:


1. CX00018 is admitted into evidence, except that the contents of page CX00018-0002 (ENH MN 002857) shall not be admitted for the truth of the matters asserted therein.
2. CX00144 is admitted into evidence, except that the statements attributed to third parties in the second and third sentences in the first paragraph of the email sent on October 22, 2002 at 12:20 pm from Jodi Levine to Jeffrey Hillebrand shall not be admitted for the truth of the matters asserted therein.
3. CX00405 is admitted into evidence, except that the statements attributed to third parties in the entries in the column “Supporting Comments” contained in the chart on pages CX00405-002 through CX00405-013 (ENH MM 004738 - 4749) shall not be admitted for the truth of the matters asserted therein.
4. CX01687 is admitted into evidence, except that the contents of the message contained in the email on page CX01687-002 (ENHE PK 019533) shall not be admitted for the truth of the matters asserted therein.


