**ORDER GRANTING UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA'S
MOTION FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A SUBPOENA *DUCES TECUM*
TO THE UNITED STATES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY**

Upon consideration of Unocal's Motion for a Subpoena for the Production of Documents from the United States Environmental Protection Agency and the record as a whole, it is hereby ORDERED that the Motion is GRANTED. In accordance with Commission Rule 3.36(c), Unocal may forward a request to the Secretary of the Commission, with this Order attached, for an authorized subpoena *duces tecum* to be served on the United States Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA").

Pursuant to Rule 3.34, in the event that the EPA seeks to limit or quash the subpoena, the EPA shall have the earlier of ten days after service of the subpoena or the time for compliance therewith to file any such motion. 16 C.F.R. § 3.34(c).

Unocal shall serve a copy of this order on the EPA at the time it serves the subpoena 16 C.F.R. § 3.36(c).
