**COMPLAINT COUNSEL'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR
EXTENSION TO FILE RESPONSE TO RESPONDENTS' MOTION TO COMPEL**


Complaint counsel moves pursuant to Federal Trade Commission's Rules of Practice §3.22(d) to extend the time by which complaint counsel must file its response to Respondents' Motion to Compel Production of Documents by ten (10) days. Counsel for the parties have conferred on this matter and Respondents' counsel is not opposed to this extension. Currently, this response is due on Tuesday, January 22, 2002. Under the proposed revised schedule satisfactory to both parties, the response would be due on Friday, February 1, 2002.


