Course Overview: MEDIC training focuses on continuing education and validation of Health Care Specialists (MOS 68W) medical skills ANNUALLY, regardless of any additional skill identifier (ASI). The course is based on the Tactical Combat Casualty Care (TC3) principles and ensures the Soldier Medic proficiency and preparedness. The tasks selected for training and testing address the three leading causes of preventable death on the battlefield: *hemorrhage, tension pneumothorax, and airway problems*. These are the critical life-saving skills indispensable at the point of wounding. The course provides 48 CEs and validates the psychomotor skills listed as a requirement for recertification if performed to standard.

Target Audience: The course is designed primarily for ALL Health Care Specialists (68W) regardless of ASI, and other service members in need to re-certify their NR-EMT certification.
