

Sport Fishing Regulations

Sport fishing is permitted only in Duck, Westcut Lakes, Possum Bayou, Lake Long and in the immediate vicinity of the Lake Agnes drainage culverts on the Red River. Lake Long and Possum Bayou (South of boat ramp) are open to boat access by use of electric or non-motorized boats only. Duck, West Cut Lakes, Nicholas Lake and Possum Bayou (North of boat ramp) are open to boat access with motors up to 35 horsepower.

Use of gear or equipment other than hook and line to catch fish or bait fish is prohibited.

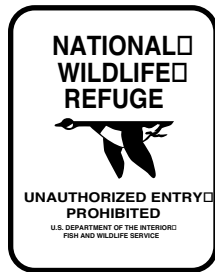
Fishing is permitted from March 1 through October 15 during daylight hours only.

Possession of cleaned or processed fish on the refuge is prohibited.

Creel limits, boating safety, and license requirements are in accordance with state regulations unless otherwise specified in this brochure.

Signs and Boundaries

Signs are useful tools in regulating the use of a public area. The wording of the sign applies to the area behind the sign. Please respect the following signs.



This sign delineates the refuge boundary. Always know the regulations before entering.



All hunting and possession of any weapon is prohibited beyond this sign.



This area is closed to all public entry. Exceptions stated on sign.



Speed limit on refuge roads, unless otherwise posted.



Only ATVs are allowed on these trails.

2012 - 2013 Hunting Seasons

Type	Season Dates	Specific Regulations
Squirrel and Rabbit	October 6, 2012 Close of State season	Closed during primitive firearm deer hunts. Squirrel and rabbit dogs permitted from end of statewide modern firearms season until end of the state rabbit season. During the special dog season, hunters must wear a minimum of solid hunter orange cap. Use of dogs to hunt, trail or take deer or hogs is prohibited.
Deer-Archery	November 1, 2012 - February 15, 2013	One buck or doe per day. All areas CLOSED during primitive firearm hunts. Areas 1B & 2B are closed during youth gun hunts and are closed to all public use after November 30, 2012.
Deer- Primitive Firearm (Lottery)	December 8-9, 2012 January 5-6, 2013 January 19-20, 2013	Special Quota Permit Required One buck or doe per hunt, hunter orange (solid orange hat and vest) required, hunters must check in and out "DAILY" at a manned check station.
Deer-Youth Hunt (Lottery)	November 19, 2012 December 15, 2012 January 3, 2013	Rifles allowed. One parent and one staff/volunteer with each youth. Two deer, (one buck, one doe) per hunt. Hunter orange required.
Waterfowl	Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday until noon during State Season	Closed during primitive firearm hunts. Boats, blinds and decoys must be removed daily by 1 pm. Non-toxic shot required. Possession of lead shot prohibited. Dogs only permitted to retrieve game.
Youth Waterfowl Weekend	State Zone Date	All refuge waterfowl hunting regulations apply.
Woodcock	State Woodcock Season	Closed during primitive firearm deer hunts. Non-toxic shot required.
Turkey	First 16 days of State Season until noon	Harvested turkeys must be checked out at Kate and Ivy's Grocery (located seven miles south of the refuge on Highway 452). Gobblers are the only game legal to harvest and the limit is one per season. Incidental hunting of hogs and use of turkey gobbler decoys is prohibited during Turkey season.

CAUTION HUNTERS, BLACK BEAR ADVISORY!

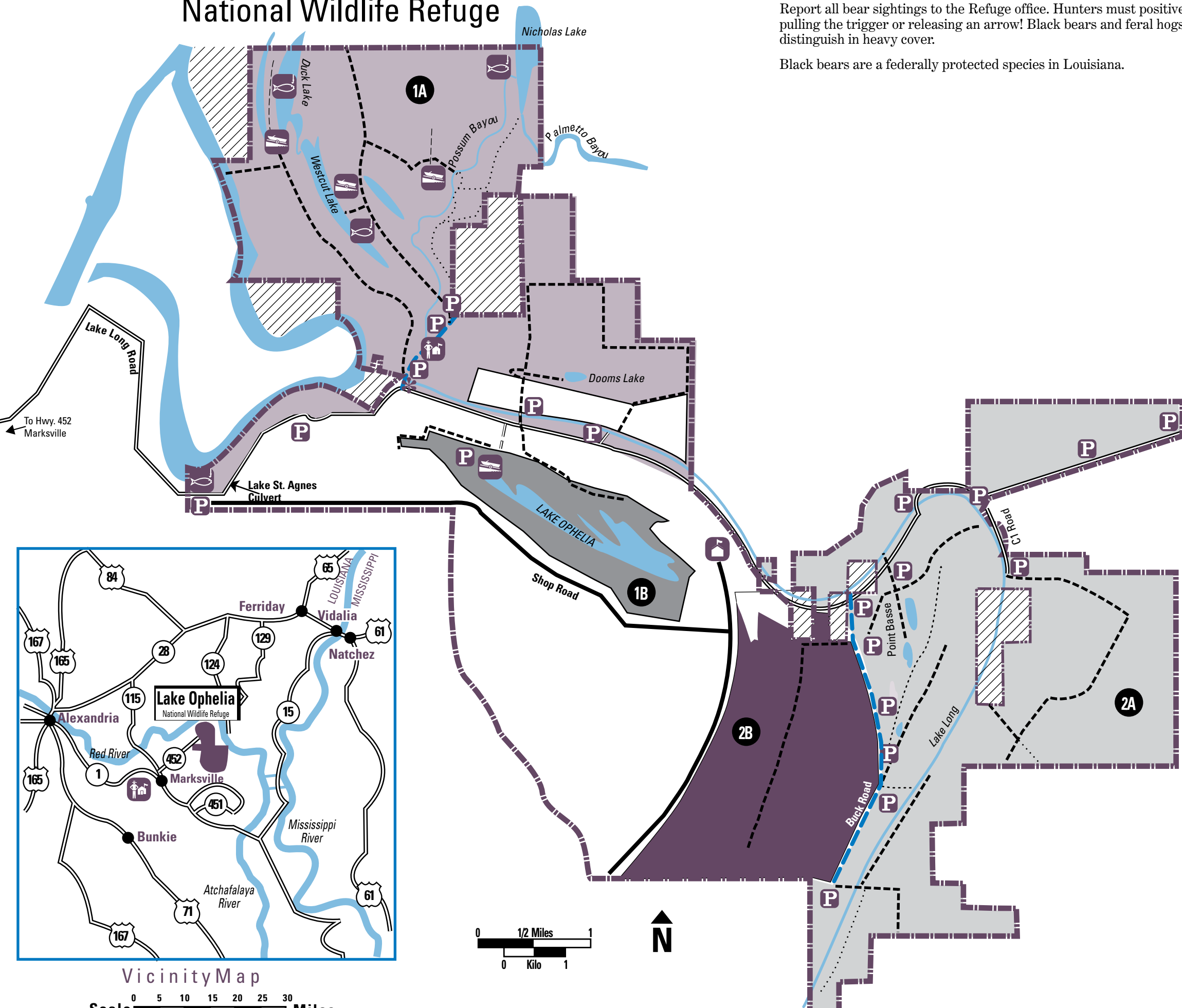
In a cooperative effort between the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries, Louisiana State University, and the Black Bear Conservation Committee, Louisiana black bear sows and cubs have been released on Lake Ophelia NWR in an attempt to reestablish these threatened bears within their historical range.

Report all bear sightings to the Refuge office. Hunters must positively identify their target before pulling the trigger or releasing an arrow! Black bears and feral hogs are sometimes hard to distinguish in heavy cover.

Black bears are a federally protected species in Louisiana.
