It is unlawful for anyone to take, harass, disturb, etc., any Louisiana black bear. If a bear approaches you, make loud noises and make yourself appear as large as possible. You may carry air horns to discourage curious bears. NEVER FEED OR APPROACH BEARS.

ATV Permits To assist in ATV trail maintenance, an ATV user permit is required and must be permanently affixed to all ATV's used on the refuge. The permit may be purchased at the refuge visitor center (Monday-Eriday) or by mail

permanently affixed to all A purchased at the refuge visitor center (Monday-Friday) or by mail, providing your name and complete mailing address (print clearly) along with a \$10.00 money order or cashiers check for each ATV permit.
