LEADERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT SCHOOL (LAMS) TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES FOR FY-13

16 August 2012

PURPOSE: LAMS is a unique 5-day course which develops leadership and management skills for first-line supervisors and mid-level leaders through an experience-based curriculum. The American Council on Education (ACE) recommends three upper-level college credits in Organizational Development upon completion of the course. Completion of LAMS is mandatory for participation in the E-6 SWE.

LOCATION: Various locations at CONUS and OCONUS Coast Guard units

DURATION: 5 Days

COURSE CODE: 340720

PREREQUISITES: Priority target audience for LAMS is E-5. Secondary consideration will be given to GS 9-11, O-1, O-2, and E-6. It is highly recommended that O-1s and O-2s attend this course regardless of accession level LAMS training. Other eligible students include CG NAF employees (all), CG Work-Life (all), CG Aux personnel (FC, VFC, and FSO), and other federal or state agency employees in positions of leadership.

HOW TO APPLY: The majority of LAMS classes are conducted as exportable training at host units. Assignment of quotas to exportable training classes is managed by the host unit. Members should contact the host unit to request a quota. Once the host unit has assembled the roster, TQC will issue orders to each member. Reserve members in receipt of TQC orders should contact their respective District (dxr) to identify funding and drilling options. Do not submit an Electronic Training Request (ETR) to request a quota for an exportable LAMS class.

Members unable to attend an exportable class may request to attend a LAMS resident class at TRACEN Petaluma, TRACEN Yorktown or the Coast Guard Academy. To request a quota for a resident class, submit an Electronic Training Request (ETR) via Direct Access. TQC will issue orders to each member. Reserve members in receipt of TQC orders should contact their respective District (dxr) to identify funding and drilling options.
