HEALTH REQUIREMENTS OF ISRAEL FOR
THE IMPORTATION OF PET BIRDS FROM THE UNITED STATES

The following requirements must be met for personally-owned pet birds:

1. Certificate of good health signed by a U.S. Department of Agriculture accredited veterinarian and endorsed by a Veterinary Services veterinarian.
2. Declaration of owner that bird has been in his possession for at least 90 days.

OTHER INFORMATION

1. A maximum of two birds per person is allowed.
2. Commercial importation requires licensing. A request for an import license must be submitted by the Israeli importer. Upon applying the importer will be provided with all details regarding imports of birds.
