## HEALTH REQUIREMENTS OF ISRAEL FOR THE IMPORTATION OF PET BIRDS FROM THE UNITED STATES

The following requirements must be met for personally-owned pet birds:

- 1. Certificate of good health signed by a U.S. Department of Agriculture accredited veterinarian and endorsed by a Veterinary Services veterinarian.
- 2. Declaration of owner that bird has been in his possession for at least 90 days.

## OTHER INFORMATION

- 1. A maximum of two birds per person is allowed.
- 2. Commercial importation requires licensing. A request for an import license must be submitted by the Israeli importer. Upon applying the importer will be provided with all details regarding imports of birds.
