

## Action Memorandum for the Kingston Fossil Plant Ash Recovery Site

The Tennessee Valley Authority is working with the Environmental Protection Agency and the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation to recover the Kingston Fossil Plant ash spill site. As part of that process, an Action Memorandum has been prepared by TVA and approved by EPA in consultation with TDEC. This document describes the non-time critical removal action that has been selected from among those proposed in the Engineering Evaluation/Cost Analysis Report (EE/CA) issued for public review and comment in January. The memorandum also includes an appendix that lists the EE/CA comments received and TVA's responses.

The Action Memorandum has been placed in the Administrative Record and is available for public review and comment. All interested persons are encouraged to review the document and provide comments.
