Annual Increase in Construction Cost Index and Specially Adapted Housing Grants

1. <u>Purpose</u>. Effective October 1, 2012, the Department of Veterans Affairs announces that the Specially Adapted Housing grant amounts will increase. In order to match the Turner cost of construction increase of 1.85 percent, the maximum grant amounts for Veterans and Servicemembers eligible for housing assistance under Title 38 U.S.C, Section 2101(a) and 2101(b) has been increased as follows:

a. \$64,960 – for individuals eligible under Section 2101(a) housing assistance;

b. \$12,992 – for individuals eligible under Section 2101(b) housing assistance;

c. \$28,518 – TRA grant funds available under Section 2101(a)(b)(1);

d. \$5,092 – TRA grant funds available under Section 2101(a)(b)(2).
