Movement Area Training for FAA Employees

This is a reminder that if you have FAA employees or contractors working on the movement area of your airfield that they MUST undergo drivers training. This training should be recurrent, at least once every 12 calendar months. If not provided by the Airport Operator, this training should be regularly audited to ensure it is adequate. We have had several Vehicle/Pedestrian Deviations occur in 2007 and 2008 involving FAA employees and contractors who did not receive the appropriate training. Remember, this training is also required to be documented as per Part 139.301.

Please review the current training procedures at your airport for FAA and contract employees who have access to the movement area to ensure you meet the above guidelines. If you have any questions, please contact your assigned Airport Certification & Safety Inspector.
