Subject: Planning Directives for Plan Revisions and Plan Amendments

To: Regional Foresters

As previously discussed in the July 15, 2009, memorandum from Joel Holtrop (1570/1920), the Department has determined that the 2000 planning rule is now in effect. This includes its transition provisions as amended in 2002 and 2003 and as clarified by interpretative rules issued in 2001 and 2004 that allow you to use the provisions of the 1982 planning regulation to amend or revise plans. Below is a table showing the planning directives to use to carry out the 1982 planning regulation.

All Service-wide direction necessary for plan development, plan amendment, or plan revision using the 1982 planning regulation is in the Forest Service Manual (FSM) 1920 or Forest Service Handbook (FSH) 1909.12. Below I have included a table that shows which chapters or sections are applicable to plan revisions and plan amendments under the 1982 planning regulations.
