

**SUBJ:** Cancellation of Traffic Management Advisor (TMA) Procedures

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- 1. Purpose of This Notice.** This notice cancels procedures contained in N JO 7110.572, Traffic Management Advisor (TMA). The National TMA Team Lead, in collaboration with the Air Traffic Control System Command Center (ATCSCC), agreed to postpone the distribution of TMA procedures. This decision is based on the National Aeronautics and Space Administration's findings of fluctuations in the delay countdown timer accuracy.
- 2. Audience.** This notice applies to Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) air traffic control facilities that participate in metering. The facilities include Philadelphia and New York TRACONs, and all air route traffic control centers.
- 3. - 4. Cancellation.** This notice cancels N JO 7110.572, Traffic Management Advisor (TMA), effective December 29, 2011.
- 5. Action.** Stop all training concerning previously-published TMA procedures until further advised.
- 6. Distribution.** This notice is distributed to the following Air Traffic Organization (ATO) service units: Terminal, En Route and Oceanic, System Operations, and Mission Support; ATO Safety; the Air Traffic Safety Oversight Service; the William J. Hughes Technical Center; and the Mike Monroney Aeronautical Center.
