2-3-1. GENERAL

- 2. <u>BACKGROUND</u>: This change reinforces the requirement that facilities have a responsibility to track and monitor those employees who are required to maintain currency. The change is intended to ensure consistent compliance in all facilities. This change reinforces the current requirement specified in FAA Order 7210.3, Paragraph 2-3-1, General, which states that employees who are required to maintain currency have a personal responsibility to adhere to the requirements specified in FAA Order JO 7210.3 regarding currency requirements.
- **3. EXPLANATION OF CHANGE:** This notice replaces N JO 7210.805 and provides procedures for all facilities to develop and maintain a process for tracking and reporting currency for those employees identified in Paragraph 2-3-2, Application. This change cancels and incorporates N JO 7210.825, Air Traffic Currency Requirements, effective September 17, 2012.
