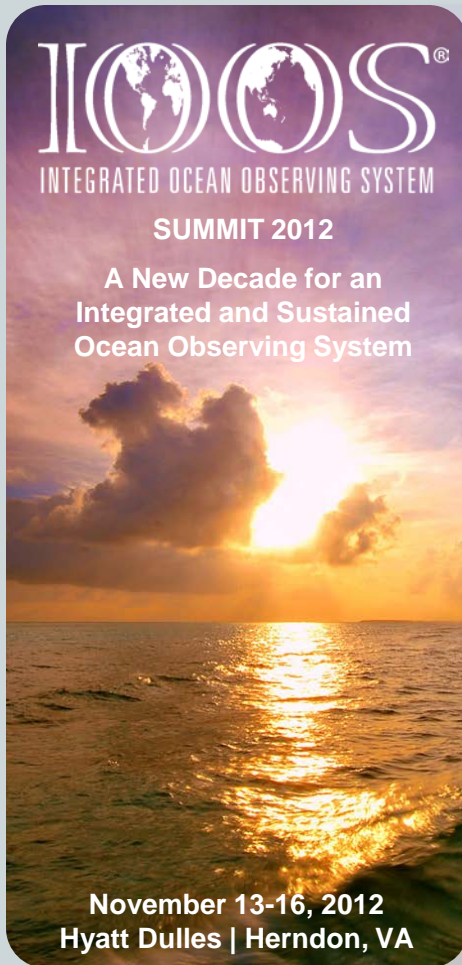

- To better integrate regional, national, and global efforts

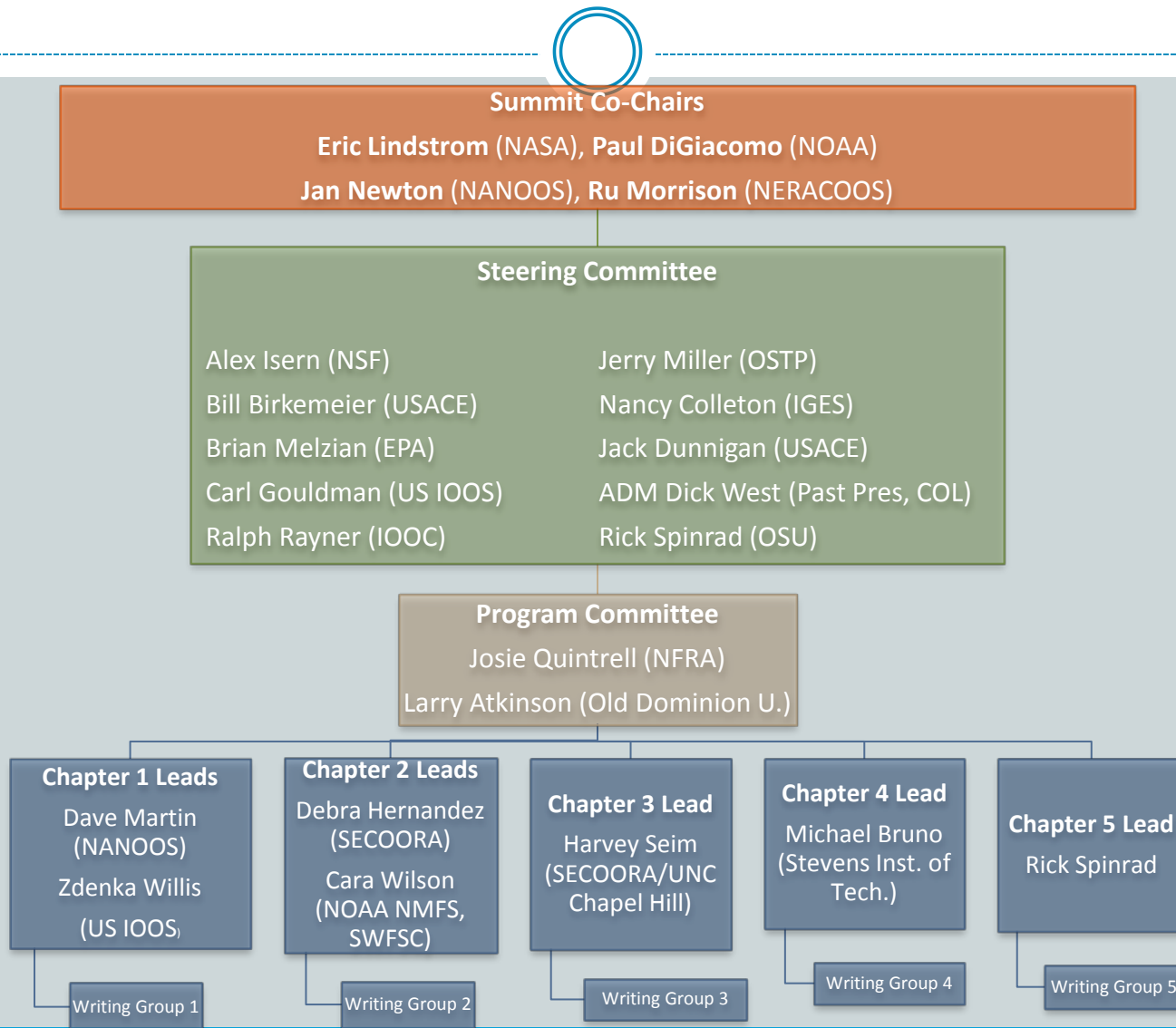
What do we want to achieve?

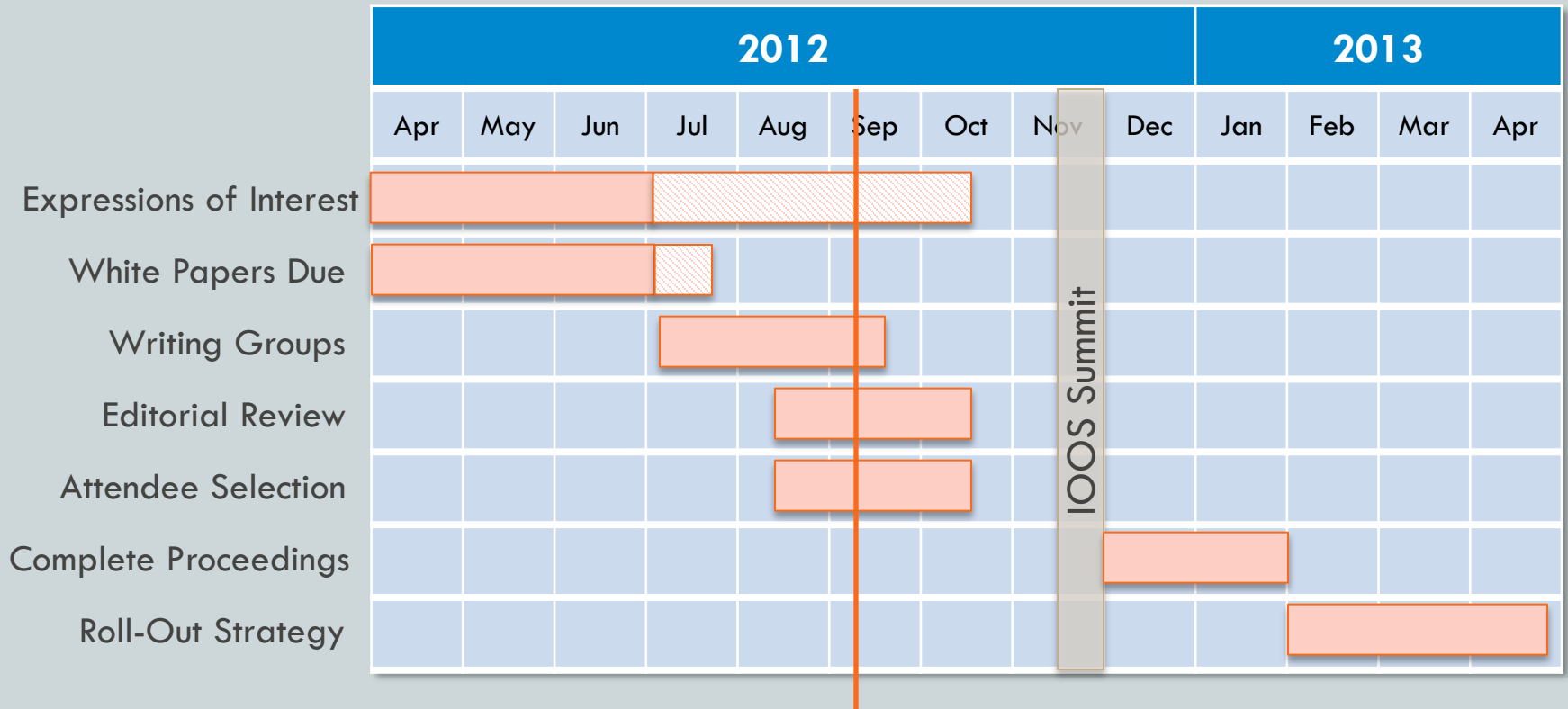
