Two truck drivers on a CB radio.

Truck Driver #1: Is the driver of the red truck that just passed me at mile marker 17 on the air?

Truck Driver #2: I'm here driver.

#1: Where you headin' driver!

#2: Gotta get this load out to the Golden State.

#1: Hey, I noticed you weren't wear'n a seat belt.

#2: Yeah, what for?

#1: Well, what if you're in a wreck, come-back?

#2: I'm not too worried see'in as I'm in a big rig, right?

#1: I don't know...If I'm in a wreck, I sure want to see my kids and grandkids again. You got any kids back home?

#2: Sure do, boy and a girl.

#1: Okay driver, so why not buckle up for them?

Announcer:

We know those of you out there driving the big trucks are professionals, and are concerned about safety.

Did you know, only 48 percent of truck drivers wear safety belts, compared with 79 percent of passenger vehicle drivers who buckle up? Who's more safe?

Keep in mind, your decision whether to buckle up affects a lot of people, not just you.
