Both sets of projections will be transmitted to the U.S. Department of Treasury.
Indiana and Minnesota met the Total Unemployment Rate threshold for triggering "on" to a high unemployment period in the Federal-State Extended Benefits program beginning June 7, 2009. The potential duration of benefits for eligible claimants is 20 weeks.	As a result of exceeding the Total Unemployment Rate trigger threshold for a high unemployment period, Kansas will trigger "on" to the second tier of Emergency Unemployment Compensation benefits for the weeks of unemployment beginning June 7, 2009.
ETA continues to provide training and technical assistance to the workforce system through a series of Regional Conference Calls set up by each ETA Regional office. The purpose of these calls is to answer questions about benefit availability under the updated provisions of the Trade and Globalization Adjustment Assistance Act of 2009 that amend the Trade Adjustment Assistance program.	The sixth and last of the Regional Recovery and Reemployment Forums is scheduled for June 10-11, 2009 in San Francisco, CA.
