Employment and Training Administration (ETA) The Employment and Training Administration (ETA) is currently reviewing applications from Arkansas and Tennessee for their full shares and Oregon and New York for their remaining 2/3rds shares of Unemployment Insurance (UI) Modernization incentive payments.	The web-site for grantee reporting of participation in Recovery Act-funded workforce development services has been built, tested and is ready for use by grant recipients. The first monthly report is due July 15, 2009, and results will be publishable by July 30, 2009.
Secretary of Labor, Hilda L. Solis announced the awarding of New Mexico's 1/3 share of the \$7 billion Unemployment Insurance Modernization special distribution of about \$13 million during her visit to that state on June 30, 2009. Oklahoma was notified of the approval of its full share of UI Modernization incentive payments. To date, \$1,656,585,169 has been distributed to a total of 25 states for UI Modernization incentive payments.	To increase transparency and provide ARRA information in a user-friendly way, DOL is testing a new map webpage that will allow taxpayers to click on their State or local area and find detailed ARRA funding information. On Friday, July 10, Secretary Solis will be traveling to Baltimore, MD and Philadelphia, PA to highlight the Department's Summer Jobs Program funded by the ARRA to show how recovery funds are getting into local economies.
ETA continues to finalize the release of several Recovery Act-related Training and Employment Guidance Letters (TEGLs), including those regarding: Providing draft Health Coverage Tax Credit National Emergency Grant TEGL to Stimulus Team for funds made available by the Recovery Act; Recipient Reporting Requirements under Section 1512 of the Recovery Act; Information and Guidance on the Two New Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC) Targeted Groups Introduced by the Recovery Act; TEGL 22-08, Change 1, on the TAA Operating Instructions, including a series of Questions and Answers; Guidance to designate certifying officers to carry out functions under the TAA program; and Reporting Guidance and Instructions for the Workforce Investment Act, Section 166, Indian and Native American	
Supplemental Youth Service Program including performance accountability reporting for the Recovery Act. As a result of exceeding the Total Unemployment Rate (TUR) trigger threshold for a high unemployment period, Louisiana, New Mexico and Oklahoma will trigger "on" to the second tier of Emergency Unemployment Compensation (EUC) for 13 weeks of unemployment benefits beginning July 5, 2009.	
As a result of meeting the unemployment threshold, Kansas has triggered "on" to Extended Benefits. Beginning July 5, eligible claimants may collect up to 13 weeks of additional benefits. Employee Benefits Security Administration (EBSA) EBSA continues to respond to over 700 COBRA inquiries on a daily basis. There have been almost 101,000 since the	
enactment of the ARRA. EBSA now has over 35,900 subscribers to www.dol.gov/cobra who will receive automatic notices of new or updated COBRA announcements with over 1,375,000 total visitors since enactment of the ARRA. EBSA continues to receive applications for expedited review of COBRA premium subsidy denials bringing, with the	
cumulative total reaching over 4,466.
