Major Completed Actions (Short bulleted list of the major actions taken to date.)

White House Council on Automotive Communities and Workers

Ed Montgomery, the Director of Recovery for Auto Communities and Workers, traveled to St. Louis, MO with Senator Claire McCaskill on Friday, July 17. While there, he announced that \$25 million of the ARRA funds for health/IT job training programs will be set aside for auto communities.

Employment and Training Administration (ETA)

As of July 10, 2009, \$1.9 billion has been distributed to a total of 26 states for UI Modernization incentive payments.

DOL certified for release nearly \$142 million in unemployment insurance (UI) modernization incentive funds to the state of Tennessee. Tennessee qualified for its full share of the funds by providing for a variety of family friendly provisions that assist recent entrants to the workforce, workers seeking part-time work and workers with children.

DOL certified for release nearly \$60 million in unemployment insurance (UI) modernization incentive funds to the state of Arkansas. Arkansas qualified for its full share of the funds by making it easier for recent entrants to the workforce, workers seeking part-time work and those unemployed for family reasons to be eligible for benefits.

DOL certified for release \$57 million in unemployment insurance (UI) modernization incentive funds to the state of Oregon, representing it's final 2/3s share.

The Employment and Training Administration (ETA) is currently reviewing applications from Delaware and Maine for their full shares of Unemployment Insurance (UI) Modernization incentive payments. Decisions are expected on both states shortly.

Massachusetts has enacted the Total Unemployment Rate (TUR) trigger, and has exceeded the threshold for a high unemployment period. Eligible claimants will be able to collect up to 20 weeks of benefits under the EB program.

Employment Standards Administration (ESA)
Employee Benefits Security Administration (EBSA)
EBSA continues to respond to over 700 COBRA inquiries on a daily basis. There have been almost 108,000 since the
enactment of the ARRA.
EBSA now has over 36,700 subscribers to www.dol.gov/cobra who will receive automatic notices of new or updated
COBRA announcements with over 1,435,000 total visitors since enactment of the ARRA.
EBSA continues to receive applications for expedited review of COBRA premium subsidy denials bringing the
cumulative total to over 5,460.
Cumulative total to over 5,400.

Major Planned Actions (Short bulleted list of the major planned actions)

The first monthly report of participation in Recovery Act-funded programs was due July 15, 2009. A fully reviewed and publishable set of the data will be available by July 30, 2009. The reports will provide information on participation in Workforce Investment Act formula-funded programs for adults, dislocated workers (including National Emergency Grants), youth and Wagner-Peyser Act activities.

ETA continues to process the 1,492 petitions that have been filed since the 2009 Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA) amendments mandated in the Recovery Act took effect on May 18, 2009. ETA is also providing training to State and Regional staff on petition processing and for program and policy functions, developing new reporting and Web requirements by the statutory deadline of August 17, and revising state reports.

ETA is compiling a weekly report, entitled the Summer Youth Snapshot, which provides highlights of Recovery Act-funded activities specific to the Summer Youth Employment Program from various program locations across the nation.

ETA staff is scheduled to participate in reviews of the Emergency Unemployment Compensation 2008 (EUC08) and the Federal Additional Compensation (FAC) program Colorado during the week of July 20-24.

Summer Youth Employment Program site visits, monitoring and technical assistance efforts conducted by ETA Regional Office representatives are ongoing through the end of September 2009.

Based on a decline in its Insured Unemployment Rate (IUR), Montana will be ending its Extended Benefits period with the week ending July 18, 2009. Montana does not have a Total Unemployment Rate (TUR) trigger.

The Employment Training Administration is working on an announcement of a new Recovery-funded grant for the automobile industry in Delaware.

ETA continues to finalize the release of several Recovery Act-related Training and Employment Guidance Letters (TEGLs),
including those regarding: Providing draft Health Coverage Tax Credit National Emergency Grant TEGL to Stimulus Team for
funds made available by the Recovery Act; Recipient Reporting Requirements under Section 1512 of the Recovery Act;
Information and Guidance on the Two New Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC) Targeted Groups Introduced by the Recovery
Act; TEGL 22-08, Change 1, on the TAA Operating Instructions, including a series of Questions and Answers; Guidance to
designate certifying officers to carry out functions under the TAA program; and Reporting Guidance and Instructions for the
Workforce Investment Act, Section 166, Indian and Native American Supplemental Youth Service Program including
performance accountability reporting for the Recovery Act.
The Wage and Hour Division in conjunction with the Office of Federal Contract Compliance will host two Prevailing Wage
Conferences in Washington, D.C. next week. The conferences, scheduled for July 20-22 and July 22-24 will provide information
to the federal, state and local contracting communities on the labor laws applicable to Recovery Act projects.
