"Increasing access to information and resources on healthcare careers will help more workers enter this growing industry," said Secretary Solis. "This funding will support the creation of an easy-to-use online platform, which will allow individuals to access this information quickly and conveniently from their homes, any One-Stop Career Center or the local library." Grants will be awarded to support projects that use virtual service-delivery models to promote career opportunities in healthcare and other high-growth sectors. The grants will be awarded in two categories: Healthcare Virtual Career Platform and Enhancing the Ability of Community- and Faith-Based Organizations to Deliver Virtual Career Exploration Services, Including Healthcare Careers. Eligible applicants for the HVCP grant are private nonprofit organizations with a nationally-focused mission to promote education, workforce development, employment or retention.
