The organizations are the AFL-CIO Working for America Institute; the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers; and the Washington State Labor Council AFL-CIO. The grants will be used to support projects that provide technical assistance and outreach to dislocated workers impacted by foreign trade.</p> <p>"America's workers have always been its greatest asset, and we must overcome every obstacle to ensure men and women across this great nation have access to good jobs," said U.S. Secretary of Labor Hilda L. Solis. "By partnering with national organizations and labor groups with strong local ties, we will provide needed outreach and support to workers displaced by trade. That is an important step in the right direction for both workers and the nation."</p> <p>Grant recipients will work with strategic partners in California, Indiana, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, New York, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Washington and Wisconsin.
