Dear Professor Oppenheimer:

In reviewing the letter of safekeeping instructions, I notice that in filling out the fees as agreed upon I omitted the words "per \$1,000.00" immediately after the rate. The first line should read, "Bonds \$1.50 per \$1,000.00 on the first \$50,000.00" and the following three lines should have this same correction. If you find that this was likewise omitted on your copy, will you please make the necessary correction.

To the best of my recollection, nothing was mentioned in our discussions about the report that must be made to the O.F.A. on any property rented for residence purposes and we assume that you did not know of this requirement, or have overlooked it. We have accordingly prepared the necessary report and if you find it in order, we suggest that you have Mrs. Oppenheimer sign it in the space indicated in the lower right-hand corner and return it to us to be forwarded to the Rent Bureau. If you find that we have not filled in correctly the information called for under equipment and services, please make the necessary correction.
