3) Summary of IACUC approved exceptions to the standards and regulations under the Act

There is one IACUC approved exception to the approved exercise plan for dogs that involves a total of 11 dogs:

"The only exception to the exercise plan will be during urine collections when the dogs are confined to their cages, which still provides greater than the minimum amount of floor space required by the Animal Welfare Act and Regulations. Because these experiments require the measurement of nutrient balance it is imperative that we get uninterrupted total collections of urine and feces. This is most easily accomplished by confining them to their kennel during the collection period as the dogs as accustomed to this environment. During this time the dogs will each be given individual human attention for a minimum of 15 minutes. Each dog will have at least one enrichment item (chew-toy, hard ball, etc.) in it's run at all times. Non-edible enrichment items will be provided for each dog during critical collection periods. Enrichment items will be rotated to keep them interesting to the dogs."
